What is a cubic yard?

A cubic yard measures 3 feet wide x 3 feet tall x 3 feet deep. This is roughly the same size as a standard kitchen stove, a washer, or a chair.

You may dispose of one (1) cubic yard of bulk waste every other week for no additional fee. Anything above a cubic yard up to 10 cubic yards has a \$10 per cubic yard fee.

> Loose Leaf Collection from November 1 - January 31

Loose leaf collection begins in November and runs through the end of January. Leaf piles should only contain leaves and rake them to the curb. Do not rake the leaves into the street.

Remove sticks, limbs, and trash from the piles. The vacuum truck can be damaged by debris put into the leaf piles delaying this service until repairs are completed.

Outside of the designated collection period, leaves must be placed on the curb in clear plastic bags. Each bag should not exceed 50 pounds.

Recycling Collection

The Town of Mayodan provides residential curbside recycling pickup. Do not place recycle items in plastic bags. All items must be placed directly inside the recycle cart provided to you. All containers must be rinsed with no food or food residue remaining. Recycle carts containing prohibited items will not be emptied. All prohibited items must be removed before the next service date.

Acceptable recycling items include:

- Plastic bottles
- Aluminum or steel food and beverage containers
- Glass food and beverage containers
- Junk mail, office paper, magazines, and catalogs.
- Newspapers and inserts
- Flattened corrugated cardboard boxes.
- Empty Aerosol cans with no caps.

Not acceptable items (DO NOT PUT IN CART):

- No pizza boxes
- No cardboard milk or juice cartons
- No styrofoam
- No plastic bags
- No clothing or similar items

No food, household waste, yard waste, hazardous waste, or other items not listed under acceptable recycling items.

Bulk Waste Collection

Bulk waste items are defined as large or odd-sized items that will not fit into your rollout garbage container.

Acceptable bulk waste items include:

- Appliances (stove, washer, refrigerator, water heater, dryer, microwave, etc)
- Furniture (couch, chair, bed, dresser, mattress, table, desk, etc.)
- swing set disassembled
- Door
- Toilets
- Flat Screen TV

The Town does NOT pick up:

- Hazardous waste, chemicals, paint
- Construction or remodeling debris
- Concrete, brick, rocks, dirt, or sand
- Tree stumps or logs
- Medical waste
- Fuel oils, propane tanks, butane, gasoline
- Batteries
- Tires
- Computers or Televisions
- General household waste or clothing items that can fit into the rollout garbage container.

Bulk waste fees: One cubic yard per billing account per pickup date will be accepted at no additional fee. For loads exceeding one cubic yard to 10 cubic yards, the customer will pay \$10 per additional cubic yard prior to the Town removing the bulk waste.

Yard Waste

North Carolina prohibits the disposal of yard waste in a landfill. Never place yard waste in your regular garbage container or recycling container.

Ordinary yard waste is the result of routine mowing and maintenance of the property. This includes grass clippings, sticks, leaves, flowers, vegetable and garden material. Place these items in clear plastic bags at curb or street edge. Pickup is weekly on Mondays.

Bulk Yard Waste Collection is provided every other Wednesday to eliminate larger sticks, branches, and debris from pruning shrubbery or trees. Items must stacked at the curb or street edge. Please cut tree limbs up to five (5) feet in length and six (6) inches in diameter. The Town will pick up one (1) cubic yard of yard waste per billing account per pickup date at no fee. Loads over one (1) cubic yard up to 10 cubic yards will be charged \$10 per additional cubic yard.

Bulk yard waste does NOT include: logs, stumps, or large limbs. The Town does not pick up debris from contracted landscaping projects or tree services.
